AQUINO (URU) angled in after taking the early advantage, set the pace under pressure for a half, shook loose in upper stretch and drew off while being kept to the task. WEST EXPRESS was well placed along the rail to the top of the stretch and finished willingly along the inside to best the others. CASH MCCOOL pressed the winner in the three path into upper stretch and continued on well to gain a share. ON BOARD AGAIN raced well back between horses to the turn then closed mildly while angling to the inside in the late stages. GOLDSVILLE raced up close between rivals for five furlongs and gradually tired thereafter. BARRIER REEF failed to mount a serious rally while five wide throughout. BILL PLACE stumbled at the start and was never a factor while four wide. MANAGER BOIRE dropped back soon after the start, angled in while trailing on the far turn and lacked a late response. SUCCESSFUL LOVE saved ground for five furlongs and gave way.

GONE ASTRAY was reserved early, rapidly closed the gap five wide on the turn, charged to the front leaving the furlong marker and drew off under good handling. NOWHERE TO HIDE angled in early, moved out midway on the turn, swung three wide entering the stretch then closed well from outside to best the others. STRONG CLUE pressed the pace between horses for a half, surged to the front gaining a slim lead in upper stretch and weakened under pressure in the final eighth. SPANIARD sprinted clear on the rail, set the pace into midstretch and tired from his early efforts. FLORENTINO (JPN) ducked out after breaking poorly, raced greenly while wide throughout. COAL BARON steadied along the rail at the half mile pole then failed to threaten while saving ground. YORE stumbled badly at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. SOMETHING GOLD stumbled at the start, raced between horses for a half and gave way. PLATTE RIVER rushed up four wide to contest the early pace, remained a factor to the turn and gave way.

STORM PLAY pressed the pace between horses, battled heads apart into midstretch and drew off under pressure. TIZ IT dueled inside the winner into midstretch and held well to best the others. MAHWELL saved ground while racing in midpack, angled four wide leaving the turn and rallied mildly. JIMMY SIMMS was unhurried for five furlongs, circled five wide and gained a bit in the late stages. PERFECT PRECISION was outrun to the turn, rallied along the rail entering the stretch and drifted out while improving his position late. DIFFERENT DRUMMER pressed the pace three wide into upper stretch and tired. BET THE LIMIT was reserved along the inside, swung five wide and lacked a strong closing response. PRINCE OMAR raced up close from outside for a half, lodged a mild bid to threaten in upper stretch then gave way. RIO MAGGIORE (BRZ) was never a factor. MAJOR GENERAL was outrun while racing wide. CHOSEN EMPIRE saved ground and gave way on the turn. LOUANN'S BOOT faded after going a half.

MISSINGLISALEWIS was outrun for six furlongs, launched a rally from outside on the turn, swerved nine wide at the top of the stretch then closed strongly in the middle of the track to win going away. CARDIFF ROAD steadied briefly on the first turn, chased five wide along the backstretch, launched a move from outside in upper stretch, made a strong run to challenge in deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. BENEATH THE CROWN steadied along the inside on the first turn, was rated in midpack for six furlongs, angled 6wide at the top of the stretch then closed late to gain a share. VICTORY ASSURED was outrun along the inside for six furlongs, swung five wide leaving the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. GOLD PAGEANTRY steadied along the rail for a half mile, saved ground in hand to the turn and finished evenly. TOBRUK set the pace along the rail into midstretch and gave way. TRIPLE BOGEY BLUES was outrun for six furlongs, steadied in traffic along the inside in midstretch and failed to threaten thereafter. SMART ENUF steadied between horses then moved to the outside on the first turn, was unhurried for a half, made a strong move from outside to reach contention on the turn, battled heads apart for the lead in midstretch and faltered late. WOODRUNNER raced in close contention between horses to the turn, bumped with KEY VICTORY while splitting horses to challenge a furlong out then faded in the final eighth. AL AMIR pressed four wide to the turn and tired. KEY VICTORY saved ground in closed contention to the top of the stretch, took up when bumped and hit the rail in midstretch and was never close thereafter. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run there was no change in the order of finish.
